We maintain a register for bicycles in the building and allocate hooks by number to individuals on request (not to apartments). Racks are limited and allocated on the basis of ONE per person.

Rule 11 of the BC RULES states that "*Provision of bike hooks in the basement areas means bicycles are banned from all other common areas including the main front entrance, hallways, lifts, and car parking spaces, i.e. they are not to be stored in apartments or on balconies. Bicycle security is at the owner's risk and expense*".

Note: Bicycles belonging to persons not resident in the building are not to be stored on site.
